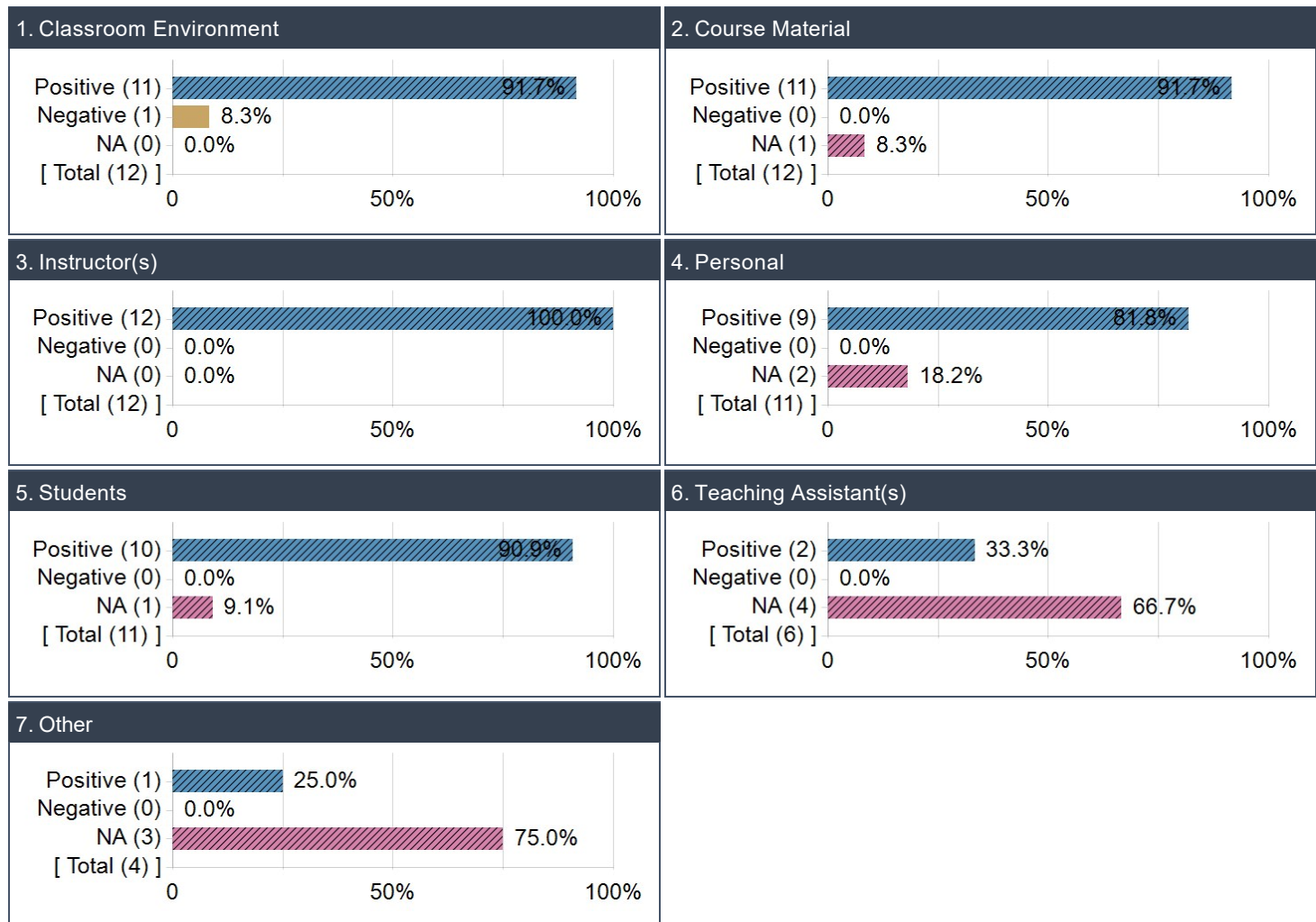
Comments

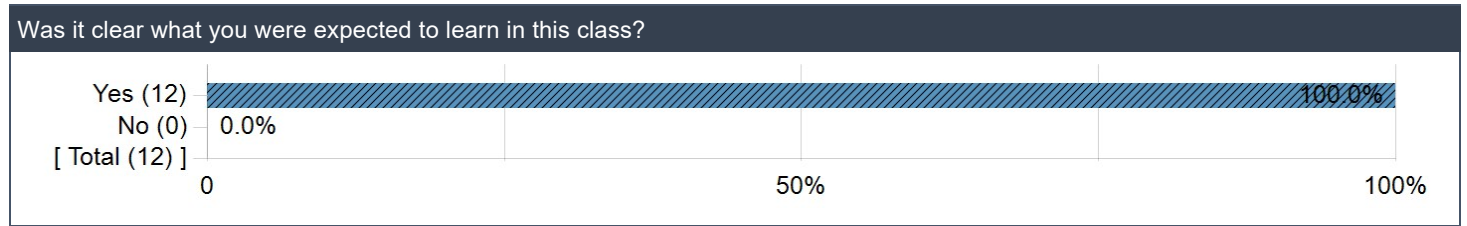
