




I was not great about attending class or reading the discussions, but that's mostly because I was very busy with other things. When I did attend class, I participated in the discussions




some lack of clarity on how participation was measured



Professor Lee was very helpful and quick to respond.


Joon is awesome! Very funny and good with relating to students

Good teacher. I liked the lectures in class.


Absolutely fantastic instructor. Very helpful, thoughtful, and knowledgeable.



The course content was very specific and didn't really help me learn about ethics as a whole. I choose to put N/A for the instructors because one was amazing and the other was rude.


